I qualified as Fellow of the Institute of Actuaries (FIA) in 2007, after reading Mathematics at the Queen's College, Oxford. I have spent the whole of my professional life looking after members, trustees and sponsors of pension schemes.

### 3 Professional career

**2000 – 2004:** Towers Perrin (now Towers Watson): actuarial advice to FTSE 250 and international private sector pension schemes.

**2004 – 2006:** KPMG Pensions – Advice to trustees and sponsors of UK pension schemes. Provided advice to high net worth members about impact of changes to pension legislation.

**2006 - 2012:** Pope Anderson LLP (now Broadstone): Scheme Actuary to trustees of UK based pensions. Worked with a wide range of pension schemes in all stages of their lifespan with assets ranging from £2million to £350 million and members ranging from management and blue collar workers to clergy and footballers.
